A COMMUNITY OF 55,000, VALDOSTA IS LOCATED IN SOUTH-CENTRAL GEORGIA APPROXIMATELY 20 MILES FROM THE FLORIDA STATE LINE.

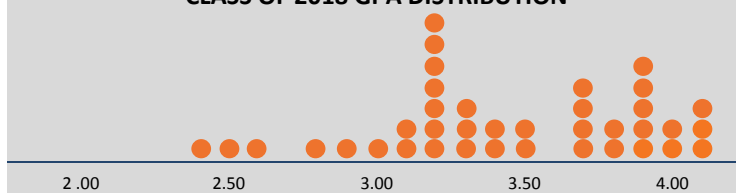

CLASS OF 2018 GPA DISTRIBUTION

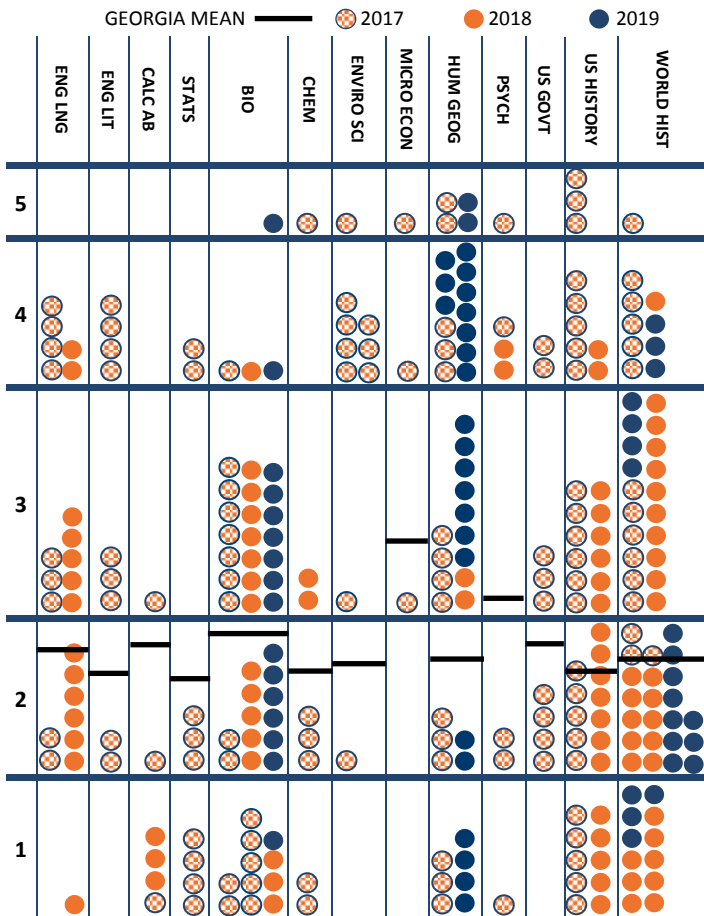


MEAN WEIGHTED CUMULATIVE GPA: 3.479
