

Important Information for Valwood Middle and Upper School Families

Tuesday, August 11 – Back to School & Convocation – 8 am

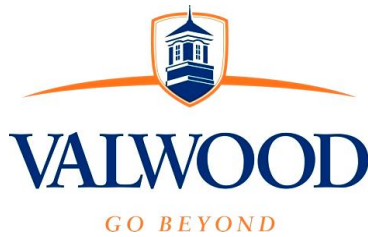
On the first day of school, **Tuesday, August 11**, we will begin the year with our annual **Convocation**. All students in **Kindergarten through 12th grade** will report directly to the gym for this special event. **Pre-K students will not attend Convocation and should go directly to their classrooms upon arrival.**

During Convocation, we will introduce our faculty and staff, recognize the senior class, and celebrate the start of a new school year together. At the conclusion of the program, students will be dismissed by grade level and accompanied by their teachers to their classrooms.

Parents are welcome and encouraged to attend Convocation. Please note that parents will not be walking students to their classrooms following the event. Sixth through twelfth grade students are required to wear “**Monday Dress**.”

August 11 is a half-day of school, middle and upper school students will be dismissed at noon.

BEFORE SCHOOL BEGINS:

Physicals - All students in grades 5 through 12 are required to have a physical on file. Completed physicals are due by August 1, 2026. Many local physicians are familiar with this form and may charge a small fee to complete it for you.

BACK TO SCHOOL:

Arrival and Dismissal

Arrival for Middle School. The Middle School opens at 7:30 AM. Parents should drop their child off with the passenger door opening to the Middle School for safety.

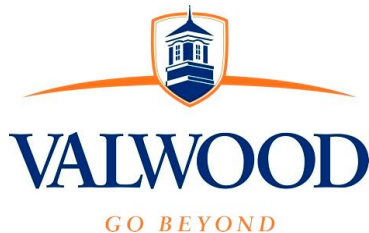
Dismissal for Middle School. The Middle School day ends at 3:25 PM. Parents can pick their children up along the sidewalk facing the south parking lot. Students will stay in their designated areas until permitted to leave by their coach or supervisor.

Pick-Up Changes for Middle School. If during the day it becomes necessary for someone other than a previously designated driver to pick your child up, please call the Middle School Office. We will inform the teacher and student of the change. Please inform the new driver he or she needs to be prepared to show a picture ID.

Late Pick-Up for Middle School. Middle School students who are not picked up by 4:00 PM. or after their sports practice will be taken to Extended Day, and the school will bill the account at the drop-in rate.

Early Check-Out for Middle School. Should you need to check your child out early due to a doctor's appointment, etc., please stop at the Middle School Office first to sign him/her out of class. Please notify the Middle School Office at least the day before a scheduled appointment.

Arrival for Upper School. The Upper School opens at 7:30 AM. Parents may drop their child off with the passenger door opening to the Dining Hall. Students who drive will park in their assigned spots and walk through the dining hall to the upper school.



Dismissal for Upper School. The Upper School Day ends at 3:25 PM. Parents can pick their children up along the sidewalk between the gazebo and dining hall. Students who drive may exit through the dining hall to their vehicles.

Early Check-Out for Upper School. Should you need to check your child out early due to a doctor's appointment, etc., please call or email the Upper School office first.

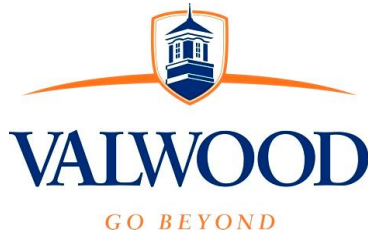
After School Hours. The school buildings are open until 4:00 PM. Students should plan to collect their books and leave school by that time. Students should not come to school in the evening or on the weekend with the hope that someone might be there to let them inside. Students should not be at school (except for specific events) after dark. Students must never be in school buildings, including the gymnasium, unless they have adult supervision.

ADDITIONAL INFO:

Field Trips – PK-5th grade have field trips throughout the school year. Fifth graders go on one overnight trip. Parents may be invited as needed for chaperones and drivers. We do not allow siblings to attend field trips.

Food Services - Pepi Food Services is our on-campus food provider. Student accounts have been set up by FACTS student ID numbers. A representative will be available for questions during the new family BBQ and open house. Some students choose to bring their own lunch, it's completely your choice. If students in upper school choose to order lunch to be delivered, it must be delivered to Crane Hall. We do think everyone needs to know that this is not encouraged by Valwood because the students have a short time allotted for lunch and often the food is not here when they expect it!

Late Start Wednesday - The school day begins at 8:00 am. On Wednesdays, classes do not start until 8:30 am. The teachers are here at 7:30 am on Wednesday so that they can have meetings, conferences, participate in staff development, etc.

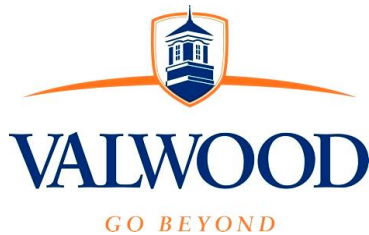
RPH – Rodgers Performance Hall located in Godwin-Holmes Arts Center – assemblies and plays take place here.
