Notes for Language Arts

- 1. Reading Readiness: Students are introduced to upper and lower case letters, letter sounds, oral blending.
- 2. Students match beginning sounds with pictures
- 3. Pre Writing: Students develop fine motor skills and learn to track and write numbers, lower and upper case letters
- 4. Listening: Students develop listening and auditory memory skills as well as expressive and receptive language skills through listening to stories and poems.
- 5. Listening: Students are engaged in a variety of activities which involve listening skills and following directions.
- 6. Students are encouraged to retell sequence of events and specific details.
