VALWOOD'S SCHEDULE ALLOWS STUDENTS TO TAKE 1 AP COURSE DURING THEIR FRESHMAN YEAR, 2 AP COURSES DURING THEIR SOPHOMORE YEAR, 3 AP COURS-ES DURING THEIR JUNIOR YEAR, & 6 AP COURSES DURING THEIR SENIOR YEAR. FRESHMAN, SOPHOMORES, & JUNIORS ENROLLED IN AP COURSES ARE REQUIRED TO SIT FOR THE AP EXAM; SITTING FOR THE AP EXAM IS OPTIONAL FOR SENIORS.
