
5th Grade Summer Projects

Rising 5th grade students are required to read one book is required to be read over the summer with assignment to be completed as the book is read. Bring book and written assignment with you on the second day of school. Students are also required to complete a math packet.



Read: "Holes" by Louis Sachar

Assignment: Please choose one of the following to complete after reading the book "Holes."

Choice 1: Create your own paper suitcase that opens and include replicas of items that you consider to be most valuable to you. Include reasons for your choices.

Choice 2: Design a Wanted Poster for one of the characters in the story. Be sure to include a sketch, last known whereabouts, crime committed, nicknames, reward, contact information, etc.

Choice 3: Create a warning poster about the yellow spotted lizard. Be sure it is eye-catching and that it contains a lot of information.

5th Grade Summer Math Packet

All rising 5th graders are required to complete a summer math packet. Most students received this packet at the end of the school year. The packet is intended to help students retain concepts taught in fourth grade. It is suggested that they complete one page per week through the summer.
