VALWOOD ENCOURAGES ALL STUDENTS TO PURSUE A RIGOROUS ACADEMIC CURRICULUM. ACADEMIC HISTORY, TEACHER RECOMMENDATIONS AND COLLEGE BOARD "AP POTENTIAL" ARE CONSIDERED WHEN PLACING STUDENTS IN ADVANCED COURSES, BUT ANY STUDENT WHO DESIRES TO TAKE AN AP COURSE IS TYPICALLY PERMITTED TO DO SO.

VALWOOD'S SCHEDULE ALLOWS STUDENTS TO TAKE 1 AP COURSE DURING THEIR FRESHMAN YEAR, 2 AP COURSES DURING THEIR SOPHOMORE YEAR, 3 AP COURSES DURING THEIR JUNIOR YEAR, & 6 AP COURSES DURING THEIR SENIOR YEAR. FRESHMAN, SOPHOMORES, & JUNIORS ENROLLED IN AP COURSES ARE REQUIRED TO SIT FOR THE AP EXAM, SITTING FOR THE AP EXAM IS OPTIONAL FOR SENIORS.
