Cancellations made after May 31, 2025 will not be refunded unless the camp is canceled due to insufficient enrollment.

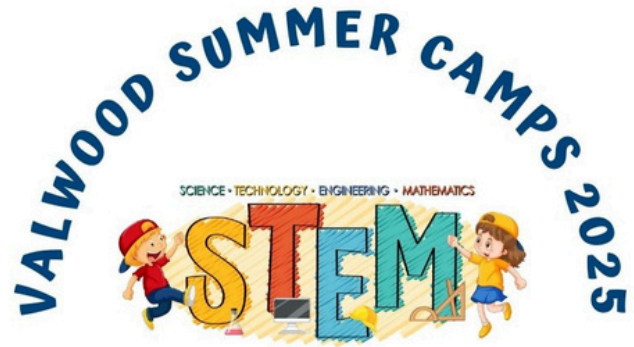
